On Saturday, September 28th, I had the pleasure of attending the 7th Annual Bill Mehr Drop-In Center Banquet hosted by the Cooperative Council of Ministries (CCoM). It was a wonderful celebration of the Council and the commitment of the volunteers who work hard to improve the lives of our neighbors.

CCoM partnered with the county to open the shelter in May of 2002. Named after the late Bill Mehr who led the effort to create the center and actively volunteered there, the center serves community members experiencing homelessness. Services cover every aspect of the human experience including food, shelter, clothing, mental health and substance abuse support, medical and dental appointments. Each year the Council provides meals, volunteers, and funds staff salaries (approximately \$50,000) at the Drop-In Center.

I'm sharing this because I was deeply moved by the testimonials and the incredible commitment of the CCoM and staff of the Drop-In Center. Addressing

homelessness is not the responsibility of one organization. It's not the responsibility of a few volunteers. We all share the responsibility to uplift those in need.





Information is collected about what health problems are affecting community members, what services are available, and what needs to improve. We get this information from health data, surveys, and community conversations. By having community members tell us what they need, we can work to create programs and services that make our community healthier.

#### Requirements

**Facilitation Training:** Two hours (online and/or in-person training) to prepare the liaison with the skills to lead a great conversation. This training will be a great skill set to add to your resume.

**8-hour Lay Interpreter Training:** Offered online by the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health and Disability Services in October 12, 2024 9-6pm online. This is a valuable step to becoming a certified Interpreter. \*Encouraged for bilingual individuals.

- If you are 18+, care about the health of your community, and looking for a way to get involved, this might be a great fit for you.
- If you are active duty or retired military, aligned with the LGBTQIA+ community, disabled, and/or an advocate
