Virginia Housing Community Impact Grant Innovation Program



Competitive Innovation Program Grants (up to \$200,000) are for innovative programs or services addressing housing needs, focusing on:

- Innovative Services: Housing-related services like property management or community engagement.
- Innovative Financing: New funding models or financial products to support affordable housing.

Competitive Innovation Construction Grants (up to \$500,000) support projects using non-traditional building methods to reduce time, cost, or resource use. Categories include:

- Innovative Materials: Developing affordable, sustainable, or available materials.
- Innovative Building Approaches: Streamlining construction processes.
- Innovation Project Enhancements: Enhancing an existing project with innovative improvements.

The Community Impact Grant Innovation Program supports technological and process innovation in homebuilding and housing services, particularly for low-to-moderate income households. It aims to demonstrate cost-saving innovations that can be replicated.

Innovation Planning Grants (up to \$50,000) help explore new building techniques, materials, or housing services, with the goal of producing a white paper to guide future funding requests. Rolling applications are accepted.
